

We know very little about this man, but his contribution in protecting and parenting the infant Jesus make him an essential part of our story. His world had been turned upside down by the unexpected pregnancy of his betrothed. Was his heart broken when he learned Mary was pregnant? He knew he was not the father. Yet, an angel in the night tells him this is from God. He believes it and that faith empowers every action we see from that point onward. He even leads his family in fleeing to Egypt to save this child from Herod's sword.

<sup>18</sup>Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way.
