AS WE GATHER

As you make your way throughout our country, you may hear different sirens and whistles, whistling out into the air to alert you to well... something. It could be a Fire, a Tornado, or an alert to some other emergency. In some places these sirens blow simply to tell you it's noontime each day. But for Episcopal Priest and Author Robert Farrar Capon, his hometown of Shelter Island had another siren every Friday at 4:55pm. He called it the "party time siren", others called it "the drinking siren." Party Time on Shelter Island. "When evening came, the owner of the vineyard said to his foreman, 'Call the laborers and pay them their wages, beginning with the last, up to the first." (Matthew 20:8) Capon says that "The parable of the workers in the vineyard paints Heaven as a party in the streaming sunlight of the world's final

afternoon. Heaven is where all the workers show up, no matter what time they get to work, and are told to waltz up to the bar of judgment with pay envelopes and bar tabs filled because someone else decided to pay for the whole thing, regardless of the effort they or we had put into our work. The Boss pays out more than any one of us deserves. This party, this bash that insists upon happening, it's still happening now and will go on forever – drowning out all the party poopers in the world. Heaven, in short, is a gift, it's more than anyone deserves, and it's fun.
