

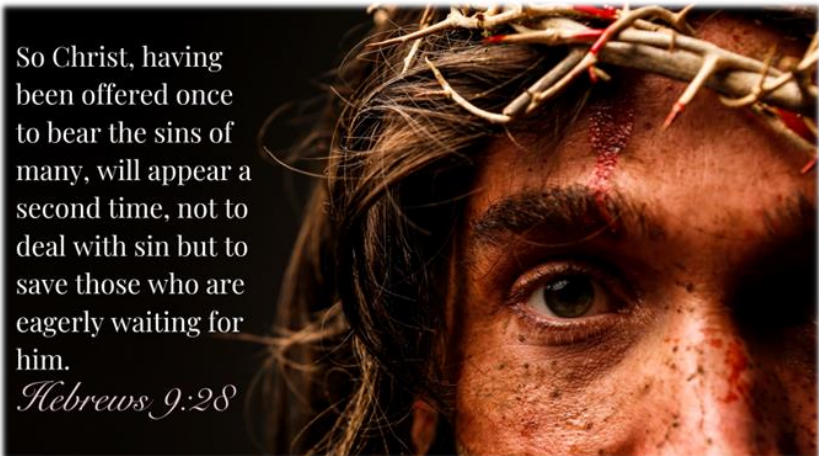

### **As We Gather**

Christ will come again. Here, in Hebrews 9:28, we have a succinct presentation of the doctrine of the second coming of Christ. The author emphasizes that the sins of the people will not be addressed again; Christ did that. When Christ returns, he will “bring salvation to those who are waiting for him.” We know all too well the reality of waiting on Christ, and that the realities we face in this life are but a shadow of what we receive in him. Hope, comfort, peace, joy... I mean we spend the last few weeks of our year talking about what is coming in Christ/. But here in Hebrews 9, the picture is of the people waiting, emphasizing aspects of salvation that remain unrealized, the day when he brings us home.
